**Kay Ives** recently completed the Fifth Year Program at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, where she also received a Diploma in 1997. Much of her newest work is inspired by the music and philosophy of John Cage, as well as the February 1999 fire in Waltham (MA) that destroyed numerous studios including that of violin maker Jerry Weene. Ives began to use smoke as a medium for image-making, along with collage, found objects, and other materials. The works are "burned fragile fragments looking for completion" that honor loss and seek to heal.
